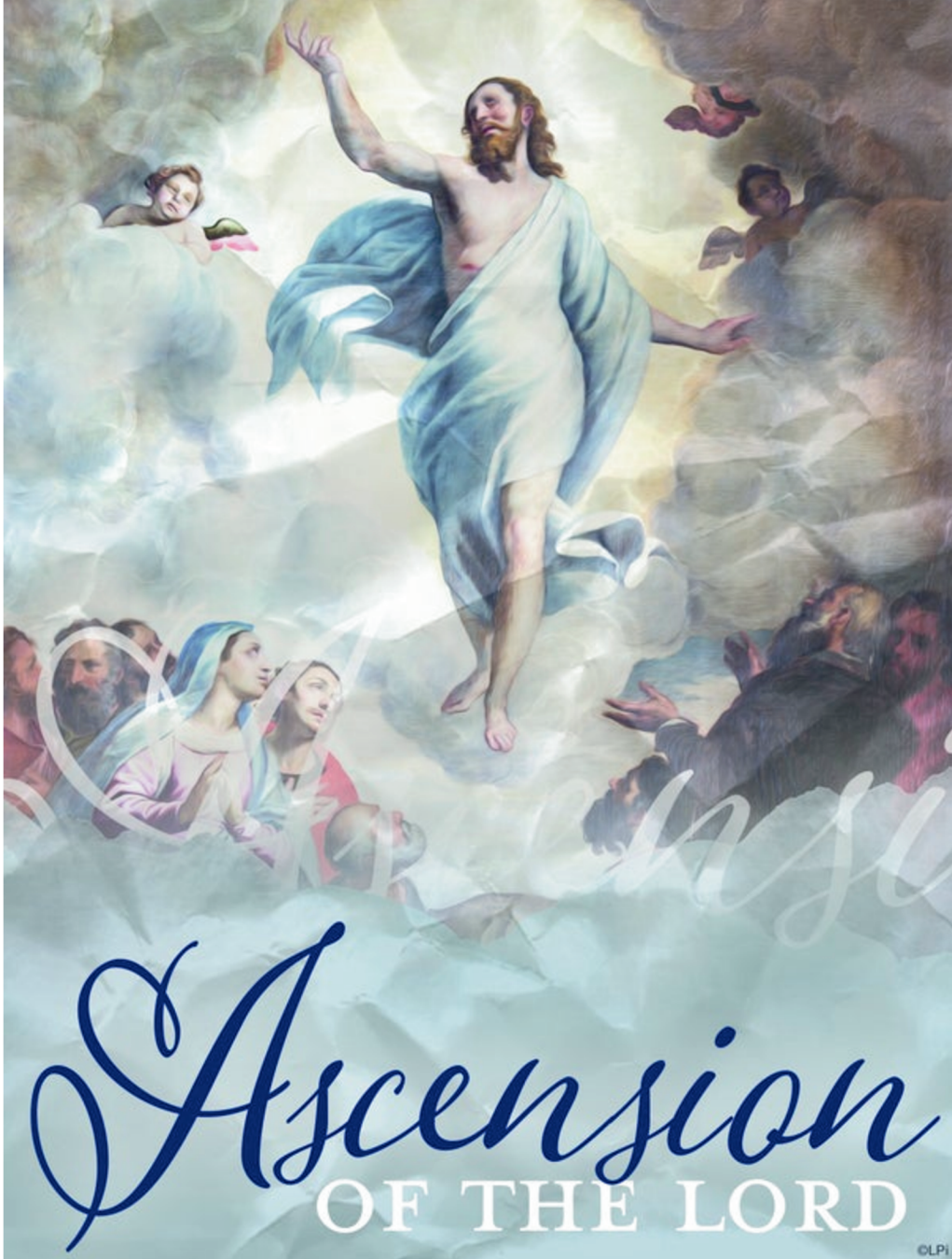

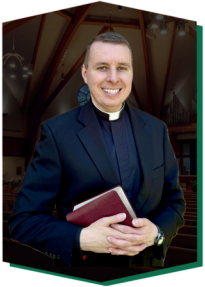

Exciting plans are underway for the St. Joseph Parish Auction, and we are looking for volunteers to help make it a success!

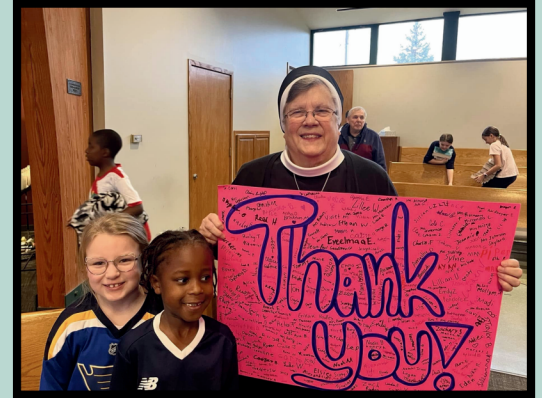

Dear Saint Joseph School Parents,

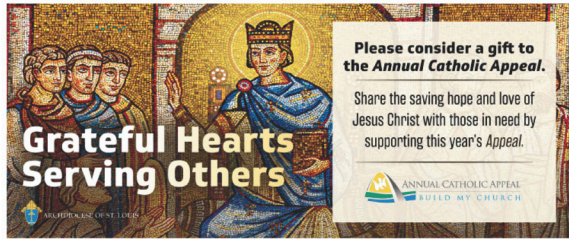
