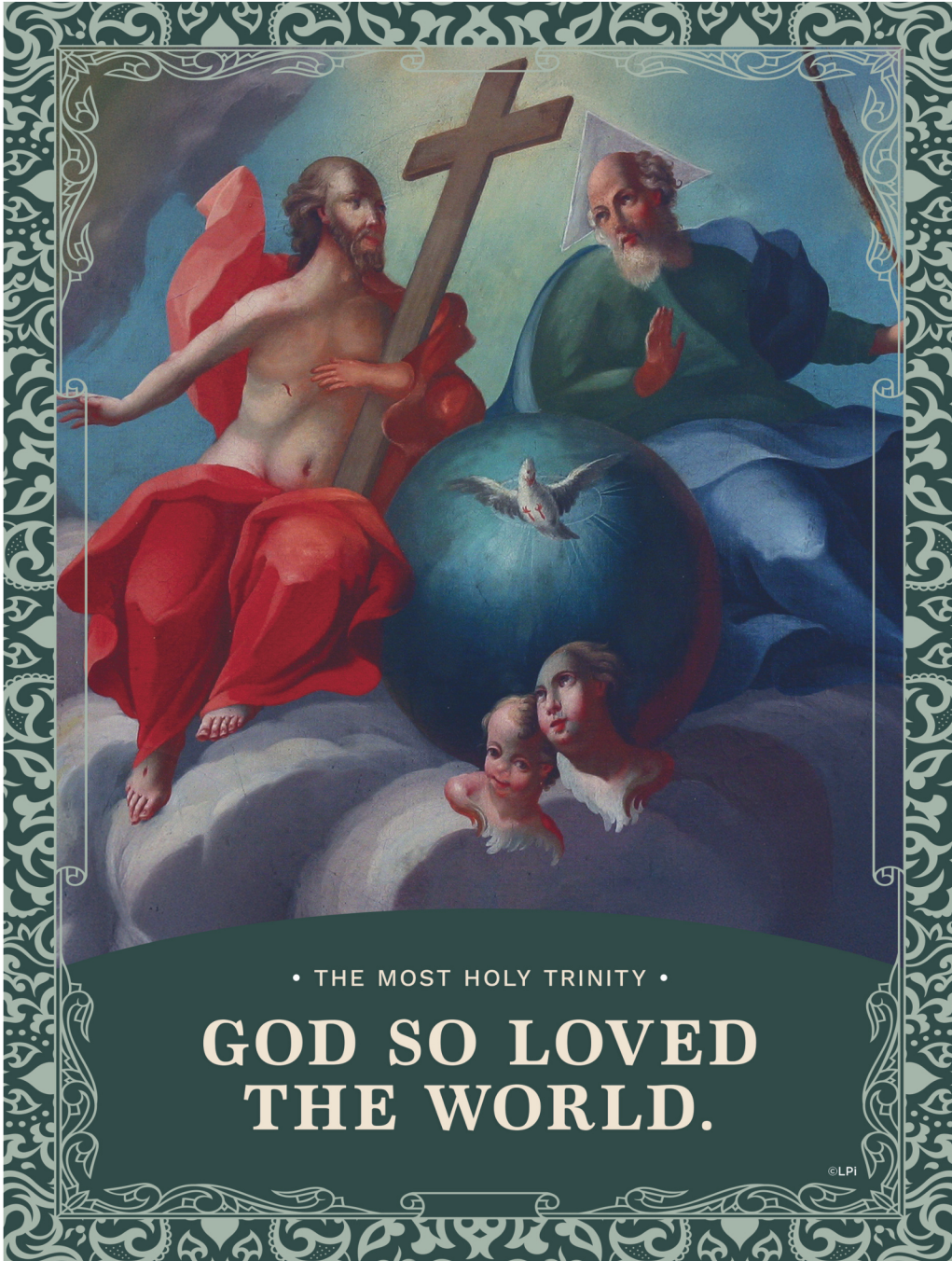

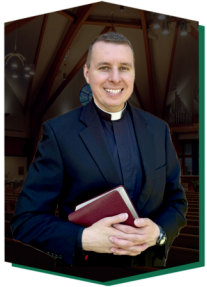

The Most Holy Trinity

As we celebrate Trinity Sunday, the Church invites us to reflect on the great mystery at the center of our faith: One God in Three Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim this mystery with a simple but powerful prayer. It is one of the first prayers we learn as children, yet it contains the deepest truths of our Catholic faith. We begin and end Mass with the Sign of the Cross, reminding us that our lives are meant to begin and end in God.

The Sign of the Cross is more than just a routine gesture. It is a reminder of our baptism, a profession of faith in the Holy Trinity, and a sign of Christ's saving cross. When made thoughtfully and reverently, it can become a moment of prayer, surrender, and trust in God's presence. This Trinity Sunday, I encourage all of us to slow down and make the Sign of the Cross with greater devotion – whether entering church, beginning prayer, or facing the challenges of daily life. In this simple gesture, we place ourselves in the hands of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

New Priest and Seminarian to Join our Parish



As was announced last weekend at Masses, over the last two years, I have continued learning how best to shepherd both St. Joseph and St. John Parishes while providing attentive pastoral care to each community. As you know, St. Joseph is a large and active parish with many ministries and pastoral needs, while it is also important that St. John continue to receive a strong and regular priestly presence.

After much prayer and discernment, the Archbishop has decided to assign an additional priest to assist our parish grouping. Beginning July 1, Fr. Frank D'Amico will join us as Senior Associate Pastor and reside at the rectory. At the same time, Msgr. Greg Mikesch will move to Vision of Peace Hermitages, though he has generously offered to continue helping us as needed. I want to reassure everyone that I will remain Pastor of both St. Joseph and St. John as well as Fr. Morris remaining as our Associate Pastor at both parishes, while we continue to be actively present in the life of both parishes. Fr. D'Amico's assignment is intended to strengthen the pastoral presence at St. John while also assisting here at St. Joseph through Masses, pastoral ministry, and parish life.

This new arrangement is ultimately about strengthening the pastoral care of both parish communities and ensuring that our people continue to receive attentive support and ministry. I am grateful for the opportunity to work closely with Fr. D'Amico as we continue serving our parish family together, and I ask you to warmly welcome him when he begins on July 1.

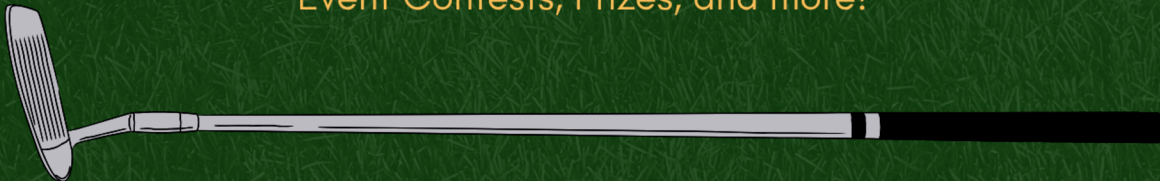
