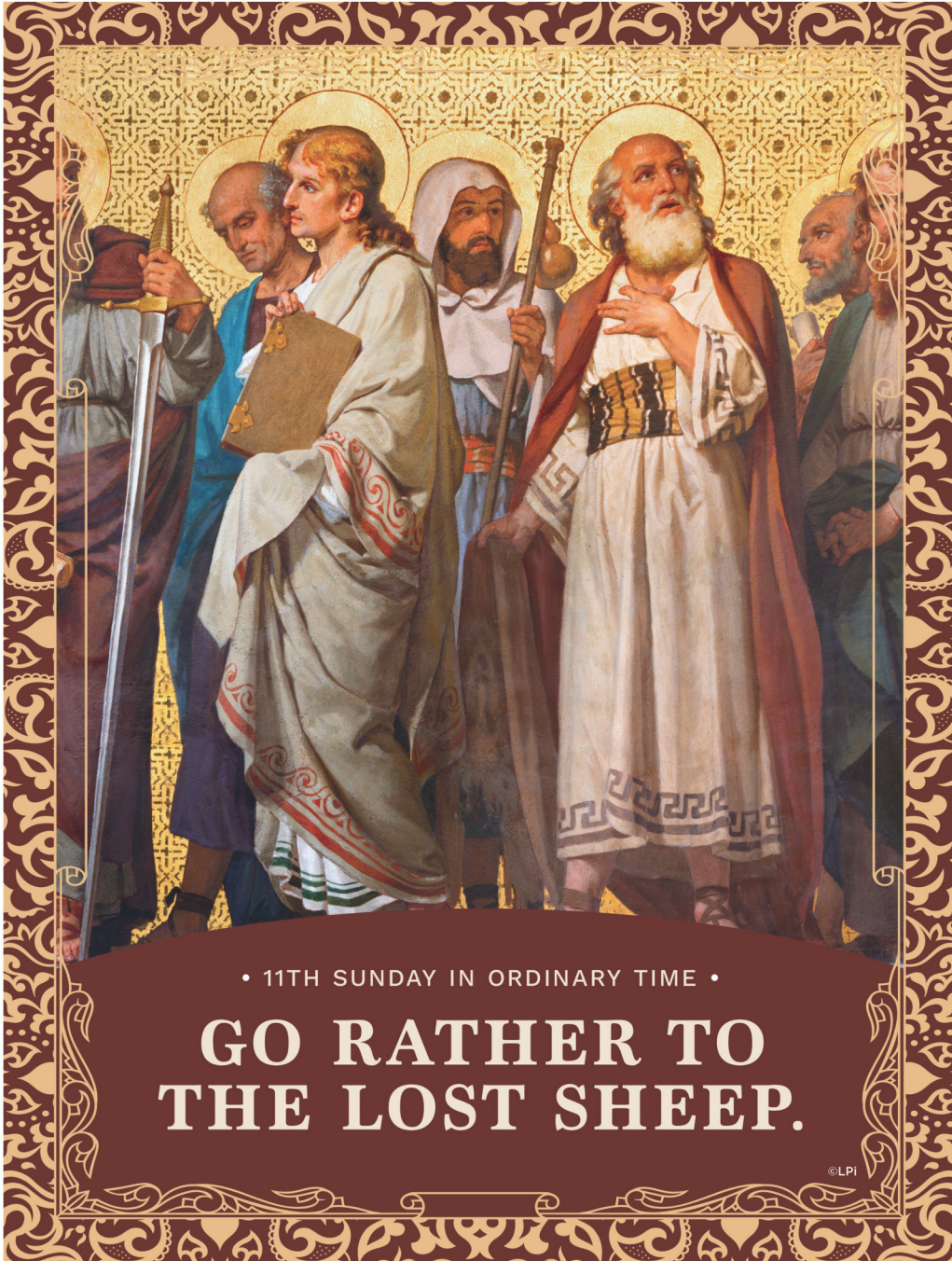

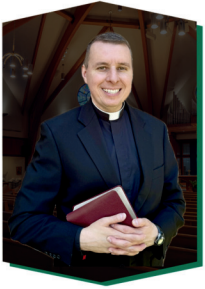

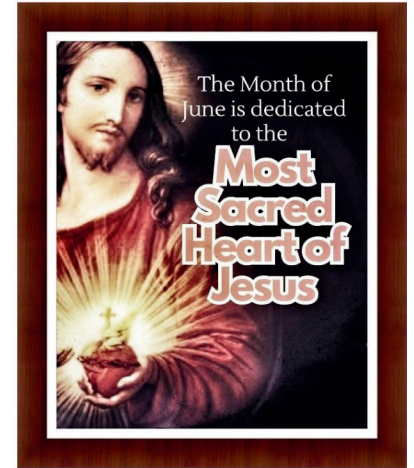

### **June: The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**

Throughout the Catholic tradition, the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion reminds us of the immense love Christ has for each one of us—a love that is merciful, compassionate, and unfailing. The image of the Sacred Heart depicts the heart of Jesus aflame with love, wounded for our sins, and crowned with thorns, a powerful symbol of His sacrifice and desire for our salvation.



The devotion to the Sacred Heart was greatly promoted through the visions received by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. During these apparitions, Jesus revealed His Sacred Heart and expressed His sorrow that so many people rejected His love. He asked for greater devotion to His Heart, especially through frequent reception of the Eucharist, Holy Hours of prayer, and devotion on the First Fridays of the month.

### **Jesus also made twelve promises to those who honor His Sacred Heart:**

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state in life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will be their secure refuge during life and above all in death.
5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners will find in My Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart is exposed and honored.
10. I will give priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. I promise that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays for nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in My displeasure nor without receiving the sacraments.

These promises are not magical guarantees but invitations to enter more deeply into a relationship with Christ. The Sacred Heart devotion calls us to trust in Jesus, to receive His mercy, and to respond to His love with lives of prayer, charity, and faithful discipleship. As we celebrate this month dedicated to the Sacred Heart, consider placing an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, praying the Litany of the Sacred Heart, attending Eucharistic Adoration, or participating in the First Friday devotion. May we all come to know more deeply the love of Christ, whose Sacred Heart continues to burn with love for His people.

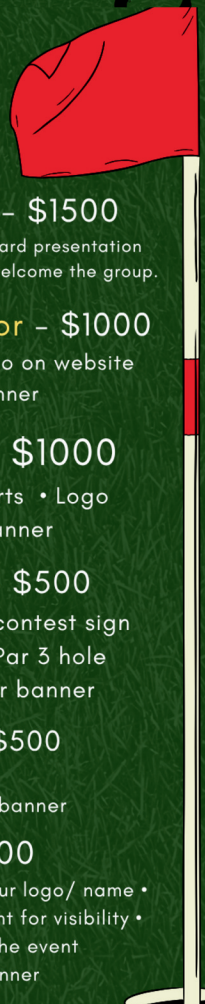

Many of us take our lives for granted. We think we have plenty of time to "repent." Maybe we should live with a little more urgency in making things right with God. This is the difference in living our discipleship out of obligation versus out of love. Obligation implies we do the minimum required. Love implies we want a relationship. God wants us to be with Him in Heaven forever, but He also wants to be in relationship with us right now, while we are on earth. Start this second - invite the Lord into your heart.
